Registration

A \$15,00 registration fee per family. This non-refundable fee allows us to service you with newsletters and mailings as well as liability and accident insurance.

Recital Fee

This non-refundable fee covers the cost of our annual dance recital held at Villa Maria College.

One student: \$60, due in two \$30 installments.

Two students: \$80, due in two \$40 installments.

Tuition

Tuition is based on a nine month season. Price includes all holidays and all cancelled classes due to inclement weather. There will be no make-ups or refunds for missed or cancelled classes unless otherwise indicated. Tuition includes one costume per class. An additional accessory fee may be charged to cover taxes/shipping (not to exceed \$20.00/costume)

▶ Family Discount: Each additional dancer from a family receives \$10.00 off per month.

▶ Boys and parents of dancers dance for 50% off the regular price.

▶ Any dancer whose account becomes over 60 days delinquent will be suspended from classes until account in made current.— NO EXCEPTIONS.

Curriculum

PRE-DANCE (AGES 2-4): This unique program introduces students to tap, ballet, jazz, and acrobatics. Students perform in one tap dance routine in the year-end recital.

BALLET (AGES 5 AND UP): Ballet is the foundation for all other dance forms. Classes are designed to develop technique, posture, and proper placement of body and mind.

TAP (AGES 5 AND UP): Tap develops a strong sense of rhythm, strength, and coordination.

JAZZ (AGES 6 AND UP): An energetic form of freestyle dance that promotes execution, flexibility, an enthusiasm in performance.

JAZZ-HIP HOP COMBO: This teen level class combines both Jazz and Hip Hop. Students will learn 2 separate routines during this 90 minutes class. (Cost is based on 2 class tuition rates.)

ACROBATICS (AGES 6 AND UP): An athletic class that involves stretching, floor work, tumbling, and dance. *(Enrollment in jazz or ballet is required)*

LYRICAL (AGES 10 AND UP): A blend of jazz and ballet techniques that uses emotion to tell a story from the stage. *(Enrollment in ballet is required)*

HIP HOP (AGES 8 AND UP): A form of street dance performed to popular dance and hip hop music. *(Enrollment in jazz in required)*

CHEER DANCE (AGES 7 AND UP): A class involving sharp, focused movements, jazz, and acrobatics. *Great for the energetic dancer.*

POINTE (AGES 11 AND UP): Ballet performed on the tops of the toes. Dancers will be placed on Pointe at the discretion of their teacher, based on their strength of technique and ability. *(Enrollment in ballet required)*

The Stagestruck Competition Company

This Elite team of dancers work in groups focusing on the well-rounded performer. Each member participates in a Jazz, Tap, Lyrical, Hip Hop & Novelty/Musical theatre routine. They also take two weekly non performing Ballet/technique classes

Dance and Acro Attire

GIRLS: Leotard and tights (Any color/style)

BOYS: Dance pants and t-shirt

No loose clothing is permitted! Hair is to be pulled back and out of the face at all times.

Shoe Requirements

PRE-DANCE GIRLS: Black patent leather tap shoes and black ballet slippers

PRE-DANCE BOYS: Black oxford tap shoes and black ballet slippers.

BALLET: Pink, split sole ballet slippers.

TAP: Black patent leather dollies or oxfords; black patent leather tap shoes for 5-8 yr olds.

JAZZ: Black slip on jazz shoes—NO LACES!!

ACRO: Half-soles or bare feet.

HIP-HOP: Black Hip Hop sneakers.

CHEER DANCE: Black slip on jazz shoes.
